## Ontario's NDP-Reality Check: There's Reason to Doubt the McGuinty Liberals on Pesticides

TORONTO, ONTARIO--(Marketwire - Sept. 24, 2007) - Today, Dalton McGuinty begged Ontarians to believe that after four years of doing nothing about them, his party would act on pesticides.
